In manual mode.. actually, you have to expose right by looking into the exposure meter (in the viewfinder, lcd, or in secondary lcd). You need to be approx in the middle for good exposure, if your exposure meter indicating left, then you'r under exposing and got to find a black picture, similarly, if you go to extreme right you are over exposing and you will get a white or similar pic..

Why are my photos black in manual mode settings? I have a ...

Manual presumes you will manage the entire 3-variable exposure calculation and the light metering yourself. If you are unable to balance shutter speed, lens aperture size and ISO Setting, you cannot use M mode (Manual). If you have learned the "exposure triangle" from books or from free Google videos you will have the needed basic principle.

Advantages of fully manual Manual mode allows you to set both your aperture and shutter speed separately, without the camera automatically changing the other to suit. Turn the mode dial on the 600D/T3i to the "M" position; Push the menu button and scroll right to the second setup menu (indicated with yellow wrench icon, as pictured); Scroll to "LCD off/on btn." and set this to: "Shutter btn." - notice that this should be the factory default setting. Also notice that camera autofocus mode was set to "QuickAF".

M (manual exposure): Select aperture and shutter speed like so: To adjust shutter speed: Rotate the Main dial. To adjust aperture: Rotate the Quick Control dial. B (Bulb exposure): Rotate the Main dial to set the f-stop. You control shutter speed through the shutter button: The shutter remains open as long as you hold the button down.
